## REQUEST FOR QUOTATION

The Consulate General of the Philippines in Nagoya intends to procure a contract for the lease of two (2) sets of thermal scanner for use in its frontline operations in 2021 to help reduce the risk posed by COVID-19, in accordance with the government procurement law of the Philippines.

The Procurement Committee of the Consulate General of the Philippines therefore invites submission of quotations for the said procurement, as described in the attached list of technical requirements.

The approved budget for the contract is ONE HUNDRED EIGHT THOUSAND PESOS (PhP108,000.00) or approximately TWO HUNDRED SIXTEEN THOUSAND YEN (JPY216,000).

Payment shall be made by check or bank transfer after delivery and installation.

The best offer shall be selected based on the lowest calculated and responsive proposal.
