ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR SINGLE FILIPINOS BETWEEN 18-25 YEARS OLD		
1.	CENOMAR - Certificate of Non-Appearance in Marriage Registry "FOR MARRIAGE" issued by PSA and apostilled by DFA in the Philippines. All entries must be consistent with PSA issued Birth Certificate & Passport.	1 copy
2.	For 18 – 20 years old - Affidavit of Parental Consent w/ copies of parent's passports	1 copy
3.	For 21 – 25 years old - Affidavit of Parental Advice w/ copies of parent's passports	1 copy
NOTES:	a. If parents are in the Philippines, the affidavit must be notarized by a Filipino Notary Public then apostilled by DFA.	
	b. If parents are in Japan, they can execute the affidavit at the Consulate.	
	c. If parents are deceased, submit the DFA authenticated PSA Issued Death Certificate.

1.	Birth Certificate Issued by PSA and Apostilled by the DFA.	1 copy
2.	Advisory on Marriage issued by PSA and Apostilled by the DFA.	1 copy
3.	Annotated Marriage Certificate or ROM issued by PSA and Apostilled by the DFA.	1 copy
4.	Philippine Judicial Recognition of Foreign Divorce with Certificate of Finality by Philippine Court and Apostilled by the DFA.	1 copy
5.	Record of Divorce in Japan	
	a. If former spouse is Japanese, submit Family Registry (Koseki Tohon) reflecting the couple's place and date of divorce.	1 copy
	b. If former spouse is foreign national other than Japanese, please submit Certificate of Acceptance of Divorce (Juri Shomeisho) showing the place & date of Divorce.	1 copy
FOR FILIPINO WHOSE FORMER MARRIAGE WAS ANNULLED IN THE PHILIPPINES		
1.	Advisory on Marriage issued by PSA and apostilled by the DFA.	1 copy
2.	Annotated Marriage Certificate or ROM issued by PSA and Apostilled by the DFA.	1 copy
3.	Philippine Judicial Recognition of Annulled Marriage with Certificate of Finality by the Philippine Court and Apostilled by the DFA.	2 copies
FOR WIDOWED APPLICANT (must wait for 300 days after the death of Spouse before applying LCCM)

1.	LCCM for Japanese Applicant Form	1 copy
2.	Residence Card or Juminhyou (Residence Certificate)	1 copy
3.	Family Registry (Koseki Tohon) indicating previous records of marriage, divorce and death of former spouse	1 copy
4.	Valid passport or any valid ID with picture	1 copy
5.	Passport-sized photo	1 piece
<u>Requirements for a Foreign National other than a Japanese</u>		
1.	LCCM for Other Foreign National Applicant Form	1 copy
2.	Valid passport or any valid ID with picture	1 copy
3.	Residence Card	1 copy
4.	Passport-sized photo	1 piece
5.	Certificate of LCCM (or its equivalent) from his/her Embassy or Consulate in Japan translated in English. For Brazilian Nationals, please submit Civil Status authenticated by the Brazilian Consulate.	1 copy
