**RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING, BY REFERENDUM, AWARD OF CONTRACT THROUGH GPBB RESOLUTION NO. 28-2017 FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF A CONTRACT FOR THE LEASE OF MOTOR VEHICLE FOR THE CONDUCT OF NAGOYA PCG's TEAM BUILDING ACTIVITY AND OCULAR VISIT TO FUKUI AND ISHIKAWA ON 22-23 OCTOBER 2022**

**WHEREAS**, the Consulate General of the Philippines, Nagoya intends to undertake immediate procurement of a contract for the lease of motor vehicle for the conduct of its Team Building Activity and Ocular Visit to Fukui and Ishikawa prefectures on 22-23 October 2022;

**WHEREAS**, the procurement of a contract for the lease of motor vehicle has an Approved Budget for the Contract to be sourced from Nagoya PCG's MOOE 2022 in the amount of TWO HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE THOUSAND PESOS (PhP235,000.00) or approximately FIVE HUNDRED EIGHTY THOUSAND JAPANESE YEN (JPY580,000);

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to GPBB Resolution No. 28-2017, a Request for Quotation (RFQ) was posted on the website and premises of the Consulate General of the Philippines, Nagoya reserved for this purpose starting on 2 September 2022;

**WHEREAS**, the Consulate General of the Philippines, Nagoya sent requests for quotation to three (3) different companies, namely: the **BUS TABI NET (QUOTATION SUBMITTED ABOVE ABC)**, the **SAKURA TOURIST CO., LTD. (QUOTATION SUBMITTED WAS INSUFFICIENT)** and the **MEITETSU KANKO BUS** which submitted the most responsive quotation, in the amount of **FOUR HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY JAPANESE YEN (JPY469,180)** or approximately **ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-SEVEN THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED EIGHT PESOS AND 98/100 (PhP187,108.98)** only, inclusive of taxes and other charges

**NOW, THEREFORE**, we, the members of the Procurement Committee, **RESOLVE** to **RECOMMEND** to the Head of the Procurement Committee to resort to Resolution 28-2017 for the procurement of a contract for the lease of motor vehicle for the conduct of the Consulate's Team Building Activity and Ocular Visit to Fukui and Ishikawa on 22-23 October 2022, subject to the above-mentioned requirements and provided that existing auditing rules and regulations shall be strictly observed by the end-user.
