RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING, BY REFERENDUM, AWARD OF CONTRACT THROUGH GPBB RESOLUTION NO. 28-2017 FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF A CONTRACT FOR THE LEASE OF MOTOR VEHICLE FOR THE CONDUCT OF NAGOYA PCG'S TEAM BUILDING ACTIVITY AND OCULAR VISIT TO FUKUI AND ISHIKAWA ON 22-23 OCTOBER 2022

WHEREAS, the Consulate General of the Philippines, Nagoya intends to undertake immediate procurement of a contract for the lease of motor vehicle for the conduct of its Team Building Activity and Ocular Visit to Fukui and Ishikawa prefectures on 22-23 October 2022;

WHEREAS, the procurement of a contract for the lease of motor vehicle has an Approved Budget for the Contract to be sourced from Nagoya PCG's MOOE 2022 in the amount of TWO HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE THOUSAND PESOS (PhP235,000.00) or approximately FIVE HUNDRED EIGHTY THOUSAND JAPANESE YEN (JPY580,000);

WHEREAS, pursuant to GPBB Resolution No. 28-2017, a Request for Quotation (RFQ) was posted on the website and premises of the Consulate General of the Philippines, Nagoya reserved for this purpose starting on 2 September 2022;

WHEREAS, the Consulate General of the Philippines, Nagoya sent requests for quotation to three (3) different companies, namely: the BUS TABI NET (QUOTATION SUBMITTED ABOVE ABC), the SAKURA TOURIST CO., LTD. (QUOTATION SUBMITTED WAS INSUFFICIENT) and the MEITETSU KANKO BUS which submitted the most responsive quotation, in the amount of FOUR HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY JAPANESE YEN (JPY469,180) or approximately ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-SEVEN THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED EIGHT PESOS AND 98/100 (PhP187,108.98) only, inclusive of taxes and other charges

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the members of the Procurement Committee, RESOLVE to RECOMMEND to the Head of the Procurement Committee to resort to Resolution 28-2017 for the procurement of a contract for the lease of motor vehicle for the conduct of the Consulate's Team Building Activity and Ocular Visit to Fukui and Ishikawa on 22-23 October 2022, subject to the above-mentioned requirements and provided that existing auditing rules and regulations shall be strictly observed by the end-user.
