RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING, BY REFERENDUM, AWARD OF CONTRACT THROUGH GPBB RESOLUTION NO. 28-2017 FOR THE LEASE OF VENUE AND TRANSPORTATION SERVICES FOR THE TEAM BUILDING ACTIVITY OF THE CONSULATE

WHEREAS, the Consulate General of the Philippines, Nagoya intends to undertake Lease of Venue and Transportation Services for the Team Building Activity of the Consulate;

WHEREAS, the procurement of a contract for the procurement of Various Supplies and Equipment for the Consulate's Daily Operations has an Approved Budget for the Contract to be sourced from Nagoya PCG's MOOE 2023 in the amount of Eight Hundred Thousand Yen (JPY800,000) approximately Two Hundred Ninety-Seven Thousand Pesos (PhP297,000.00).

WHEREAS, pursuant to GPBB Resolution No. 28-2017, a Request for Quotation (RFQ) was posted on the website and premises of the Consulate General of the Philippines, Nagoya reserved for this purpose starting on 23 October 2023;

WHEREAS, the Consulate General of the Philippines, Nagoya sent requests for quotation to four (4) different companies, namely: the **SHACHI BUS CO. LTD.** (*FAIL – No submitted quotation [There will be a marathon even that will affect the date of event.]*), the **MIE KOTSU CO. LTD.** (*FAIL – No submitted quotation [No bus/es available on requested date of event.]*), the **HOTEL MT. FUJI** [*FAIL – No submitted quotation (Already fully book on requested date of the event.)*] and the **MEITETSU KANKO BUS** which showed the lowest calculated and most responsive quotation, in the amount of **Seven Hundred Sixty-Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Forty Yen (JPY769,740) only or approximately Two Hundred Eighty-Five Thousand Pesos (PHP285,000.00) only**, inclusive of taxes and other charges

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the members of the Procurement Committee, RESOLVE to RECOMMEND to the Head of the Procurement Committee to resort to Resolution 28-2017 for the Lease of Venue and Transportation Services for the Team Building Activity of the Consulate, subject to the above-mentioned requirements and provided that existing auditing rules and regulations shall be strictly observed by the end-user.
