RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING, BY REFERENDUM, AWARD OF CONTRACT THROUGH GPBB RESOLUTION NO. 28-2017 FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF A CONTRACT FOR THE LEASE OF MOTOR VEHICLE FOR NAGOYA PCG's TEAM BUILDING ACTIVITY AND GAD ACTIVITY ON 26-27 OCTOBER 2024

WHEREAS, the Consulate General of the Philippines, Nagoya intends to undertake immediate procurement of a contract for the lease of motor vehicle for its Team Building Activity and GAD Activity on 26-27 October 2024 in Nagano City, Nagano Prefecture;

WHEREAS, the procurement of a contract for the lease of motor vehicle has an Approved Budget for the Contract to be sourced from Nagoya PCG's MOOE 2022 in the amount of TWO HUNDRED THIRTY-TWO AND ONE HUNDRED NINETY-TWO PESOS (PhP232,192.00) or approximately SIX HUNDRED FORTY THOUSAND YEN (JPY640,000);

WHEREAS, pursuant to GPBB Resolution No. 28-2017, a Request for Quotation (RFQ) was posted on the website and premises of the Consulate General of the Philippines, Nagoya reserved for this purpose starting on 3 July 2024;

WHEREAS, the Consulate General of the Philippines, Nagoya sent requests for quotation to three (3) different companies, namely: the **INUYAMA TOURIST CO. LTD. (QUOTATION SUBMITTED INSUFFICIENT)**, the **AICHI SEIBU SIGHTSEEING BUS (QUOTATION SUBMITTED INSUFFICIENT)** and the **MEITETSU KANKO BUS** which submitted the most responsive quotation, in the amount of **SIX HUNDRED THIRTY-FOUR THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED TEN YEN (JPY634,210)** or approximately **ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-SEVEN THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED EIGHT PESOS AND 16/100 (PhP187,108.16)** only, inclusive of taxes and other charges

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the members of the Procurement Committee, **RESOLVE** to **RECOMMEND** to the Head of the Procurement Committee to resort to Resolution 28-2017 for the procurement of a contract for the lease of motor vehicle for the conduct of the Consulate's Team Building Activity and GAD Activity on 26-27 October 2024 in Nagano City, Nagano Prefecture, subject to the above-mentioned requirements and provided that existing auditing rules and regulations shall be strictly observed by the end-user.
